Activity

WHAT YOU NEED : "Spinner Template"
Activity Page, paper plates, markers, scissors, pennies, Bibles, and stickers

WHAT YOU DO :

- Look up Psalm 145:3 and read it together
- Give your child a paper plate and a "Spinner Template."
- Guide them to trace the "Spinner Template" on their paper plate and cut out the circle.
- Help kids fold the disc in half and cut a quarter-inch slit in the center.
- Tell them to write the memory verse on the cut-out circle and decorate it.
- When they are finished, help your kids put a penny in the slit in the center. It may take a bit of wiggling to secure the penny in the slit.
- On a hard surface, like a table or non-carpeted floor, challenge kids to spin the disc by spinning the penny.

WHAT YOU SAY:

- "Such creative Verse Spinners! You did a great job memorizing our verse this month! "
- Let's say Psalm 145:3 together. 'Lord, you are great. You are really worthy of praise. No one can completely understand how great you are.' (NIRV)
- God IS great! And we should share His greatness with others. God created you to share His story, and share who He is."

Talk about the Bible Story

Who told you the story of Jesus for the first time?

When Jesus told His followers to be the salt and light of the world, what did He mean? (*Jesus wants us to tell others about Him and His story.*)

Have you ever told someone about Jesus? If so, how did it go? If not, is there something that makes you nervous about telling Jesus' story?

What are some creative ways we can tell others about Jesus? (*Write them a note, invite them to a Small Group sleepover, be kind and loving no matter what.*)

How we live our lives can point others to Jesus, just as much as what we say—and sometimes even more so! Let's make a commitment as a family to use the creativity God gave us to show others that we know and love Jesus. God created us to share His story.



Prayer

Use this prayer as a guide, either after talking about the Bible story or sometime before bed tonight:

"God, we are thankful for the gift of your Son, Jesus. Because of Jesus, we can be in Your family forever. Help us look for creative ways to share Your story with others.
