

Bible Story


Joseph Gets a Coat and

Activity 1

Connect the Dots Coat
What You Need

- [Click here](#) to print out the dot to dot coat.
- Grab anything to color with.

What You Do

During the Activity: Encourage your children to connect the dots on the page to reveal the coat. Children may color the picture after connecting the dots.

Activity 2

Color the Coat
What You Need

- [Click here](#) to print out the coat template.
- Small and medium sized felt pieces of various colors
- Permanent marker
- Scissors
- Glue

What You Do

- Print and cut out the coat template.
- Lay the coat template on top of the medium-size felt piece.
- Trace around the template.
- Remove the template and cut the felt on the lines.
- You should have a felt "coat."
- Cut the smaller felt pieces into different shapes such as circles, rectangles, squares, and triangles.
- Challenge your children to "color" the coat with the shapes by gluing the shapes onto the felt coat. Continue the activity until the entire coat is covered with the shapes.
