## Activity 1

### Raining Bubbles

- Bubble solution and a bubble wand

Have the kids stand in front of you. Let them know that when you blow the bubbles, they can pop them and when they pop the bubbles, they have to say, 'God's got it!' While the kids are having fun:

**Say:** "God's got it! God is with us everywhere, all the time! He helps us and listens to us! God's got it!"

### Moses In The Basket

- Green construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue sticks

Copy "Moses' Basket" on cardstock, one per child, if you printed the B & W activity page, have the kids color it, when they finish, help the kids cut construction paper into half-inch strips. Ask them to use the pieces of green paper for the reeds and glue them on to hide Moses. While the kids are working, talk to them about today's story.

**Say:** We learned that the mean pharaoh in charge of all of Egypt made a rule that baby boys like Moses had to be taken away! Baby Moses' mom did not want him taken away, but she knew God would take care of him. Moses' mom made a basket, and she and Moses' sister took him to the river to hide him in the reeds.
