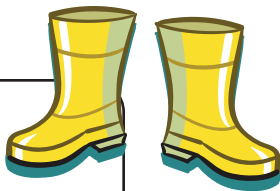

Bible Story

Activity 1

Colors Of Fire

- Red, yellow and orange pom poms
- Red, yellow and orange cups
- Plastic container

Place all of the pom poms in the plastic container. Place the three cups near the pom poms. Show the children how to sort the pom poms: red pom poms in the red cup, yellow pom poms in the yellow cup, and the orange pom poms in the orange cup. Encourage them to sort the pom poms. While the kids are working, talk to them about the story they will hear.

Say: Red, yellow, and orange are the same colors as fire. We never EVER touch real fire. Do we? No way! Today's Bible story today has fire in it. I can't wait to hear it!

Activity 2

Dance Party

- Ribbons (one-foot lengths, four pieces per child)
- Craft sticks (1 per child)
- Tape
- Music

Give each child a craft stick, the ribbon and some tape. Help the kids secure four pieces of ribbon to their craft stick. While they are working, talk to them about today's Bible story.

Say: There were three men—Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego—who entered the fiery furnace. But they weren't alone! God sent an angel to protect them so there were FOUR in the furnace. When they finish, turn on the music. Encourage the children to dance and wave their ribbons. Have fun!!!
