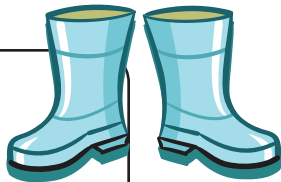

Activity 1

Animal Sounds

- No supplies needed

Have the children stand up and follow the video instructions. Explain to the children that they will hear an animal sound. When they hear it, they can call out the animal then act like that animal.

Animal sounds:

Dog Barking, Cat meowing, Snake hissing, Frog ribbiting, Horse neighing, Pig oinking, Cow mooing, Rooster cockle-doodle-dooing

Say: "You did an awesome job naming and pretending to be all these animals! In our Bible story, we'll hear about a man named Noah who listened to God then ended up with a LOT of animals on his boat.

- Cardstock
- Avery® #5160 labels or regular paper
- Glue
- Brown paper bags
- Toilet paper tubes (cut in 2 parts)
- Scissors

Copy "Boat" on cardstock, copy "Animals" on the label or regular paper, one set per child. Talk to the kids about what animals they have and what sounds those animals make. Have the kids glue the boat to the brown paper bag and glue the animals to the toilet paper roll. Encourage the kids to march the animal into the boat two by two into the boat. When the kids are working, they talk to them about today's story

Say: "Today, we heard one of my favorite Bible stories. God told Noah to build a boat and fill it with two of every animal. Let's make one to play with.

Prayer

"Dear God, Thank You for making so many wonderful animals. Thank You for putting them on the boat with Noah and keeping all of them safe. Help us trust that You will always keep Your promises and no matter what happens, You've got it. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."
