Bible Story

Hagar
(Genesis 21:14-20)

Say This

Who's got it?
God's got it.

Activity 1

Cup Phones

- Plastic cups (16 ounces 2 per child)
- Yarn (six-foot)
- Masking tape
- Scissors

Help the kids Poke a hole in the bottoms of cups. Feed one end of a section of the yarn into the hole in one of the cups from the outside. Tape the end of the yarn inside the bottom of the cup. Repeat with the second cup. The set of two cups will be one phone.

Encourage one family member to talk into a cup while the other family member holds the other cup to their ear. When it's your turn to talk on the phone, talk about today's story.

Say: Today, we'll hear a Bible story about how God hears us all of the time!

Activity 2

Sand Hop

- Brown construction paper
- Floor tape
- Memory Verse. [Click here to print](#)

Cut the construction paper in 10 squares and let the kids know that they are going to pretend the brown paper squares is sand. Tape the squares in a pathway on the floor about a foot apart. Invite the children to hop from square to square as they say the memory verse. "I see sand! It looks just like the desert in our story today. Let's get hopping!" Repeat until every family member has a turn. While the family is playing, remind them of what they just learn.

Say: It's fun pretending to be in a desert like Hagar in the Bible story. Our memory verse tells us that God is always with us, wherever we are!

Prayer

"Dear God, You know everything we need because You are always with us. Thank You for loving us and giving us what we need. Help us trust that You know what is best and You have the power to give us what we need. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."
