For this activity you need to print 2 decks of cards. One deck of cards will have the phrase "Thank You" written in a different language. The other deck will have the name of the languages. These cards are totally shuffled and out of order. Your job is to work as a family to connect each "Thank You Card" to its corresponding "Language Card." When you think you have them all correct check the answers key page. If you want to make it a competition, split your family in two groups to see who can figure out the correct answers first!

(Optional) Use a mobile device to say "thank you" in the various languages. You can use a translation app if you have one on your phone.

Activity 2

Remember to say thank you

Decorate the blank slap bracelets to help you remember to say thank you everyday. You can use markers and stickers to decorate your bracelet. If you did not buy our supply kit for the month, then you can use paper or even tape to create a thank you bracelet. Be creative with what you have at your home.

SAY: When you say thank you to the people who help you, you're doing what God wants you to do. God wants you to say thank you! Saying thank you helps you become more grateful. And saying thank you to people who help you makes them happy! Who can you say thank you to for helping you this week? (God, my mom, my teacher, my bus driver) This week, wear your bracelet as a way to help you remember to say thank you.

How many men in the story did Jesus heal? (*10*) How


many men came back to thank Jesus? (*one*) Why
