Activity 1

Helpers Help

- "Helpers" Activity Page [Print in color](#) [Print B&W](#)
- Cardstock
- Scissors
- Six toilet paper tubes
- Tape

Copy "Helpers" on cardstock and cut out, one set per child. Have the children tape pictures to the toilet paper tubes. Talk about how each community helper helps his/her neighbors. Talk about other people who help us and how we can be helpers.

Say: Look what I have for us to play with today. These are people whose job it is to help us. Who is this person? (*Hold up the policeman.*) That's right, this is a policeman. Policemen help us by keeping us safe, and sometimes they direct traffic. What about this person? (*Hold up the doctor.*) That's right, a doctor! Doctor's check us out, keep us healthy, and help us feel better when we're sick. Who is this person? (*Hold up a teacher.*) A teacher! A teacher loves us and helps us learn new things. What about this person? (*Hold up a fireman.*) A fireman. Firemen help put fires out. Who is this? (*Hold up mailman.*) It's a mailman! Mailman and women deliver letters and packages. What about this one? (*Hold up the grocery clerk.*) This one is a grocery clerk. They help us when we buy groceries. Now that we've met all our helpers, I want you to show me how these helpers help. (Pause.) Who else can help us? (Pause.) Moms, dads, brothers, sisters, grandparents, aunts, uncles, and neighbors can help, too." Today, we'll hear a story about how lots of different people came to help a man named Nehemiah.

Activity 2

Wall Puzzle

- Scissors

Copy "Wall Puzzle" on cardstock and cut on the dotted lines, one puzzle per child. Encourage the children to put the puzzles together while you say the memory verse.

Say: Let's do this puzzle! (Point.) We have a puzzle to put together. I can't wait to see what they are! (Do activity.) It says the memory verse on a wall! Let's say our memory verse together!"
